### **7-18 December, Klimaforum, Copenhagen, Denmark**

While negotiators attempt to reach a new climate deal at COP15 in the Bella Center, people from all over the world will debate how to fight climate change at [Klimaforum09](#) in the heart of Copenhagen. “We need a new political agreement on climate change, but to solve this problem everybody has to get involved in a process of making more fundamental changes,” says Niels Fastrup, spokesperson for Klimaforum09. The forum will take place from December 7 to 18 and is organised by Danish NGOs and partly financed by the Danish Government.
