Resolution on finances for IPB Council Meeting 2022:

The IPB council members decide to adopt the following resolution:

On membership fees:

Organizational members should pay a minimum annual fee of 100 Euros or a monthly fee of 8,50 Euros. Larger organizational members (determined by the size of their general operational budget) should pay an annual fee of 800 Euros or a monthly fee of 66,75 Euros.

Individual members should pay a minimum fee of 50 Euro per year; students and youth should pay at least 20 Euro per year. The fee for a lifelong membership is 500 Euros or more.

In both cases, exceptions – particularly for those in the global south or serving underprivileged communities – may apply after consultation with and decision by the IPB treasurer.

On a campaign for individual memberships:

The IPB council recognizes that membership fees are an important leg of IPB's financial well-being. The IPB council decides to start a 12 months campaign to gain 100 new individual members and 10 new lifelong individual members. All member organizations and individual members are requested to actively advertise for new individual members of IPB. All board and council members are being asked to commit to the campaign and to ask for individual membership in their networks. The IPB Council asks the IPB Board to explore possibilities to improve the benefits of individual membership in IPB.

The IPB Council also asks the IPB Board to explore a special fundraising campaign dedicated to funding staff members for the office.
