In the year 697 AD, the Synod of Birr (Ireland) enacted a law to protect women, youth, clergy and those in the protection of the church, in times of war. This law, Lex Innocentium (the Law of the Innocents), also known as Adomnán's Law after its author, Adomnán, Ninth Abbot of Iona, made it a crime to harm or kill these innocent non-combatants in war or military aggression. It has also come to be known as the First Geneva Convention and the Geneva Convention of the Gaels.

Given the horrendous, destructive and indiscriminate nature of modern warfare, with its ability to kill people in their millions, destroy the Earth and her beautiful and complex ecosystems, and threaten the future of humanity and the Earth herself, we have now written a new Lex Innocentium for our time, Lex Innocentium, 21st Century.
